Habib University is a liberal arts and science institution being established by Habib University Foundation as a world class center of excellence in higher learning in Karachi, Pakistan. Habib University will start classes in Fall of 2013 and will offer undergraduate programs, with a unique blend of interdisciplinary education in Science, Engineering, Arts, Humanities and the Social Sciences.

Habib University is establishing a School of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, which will offer Bachelor of Arts in Communication Studies and Design and in Social Development and Policy as its first programs. The School will initiate classes with 80 students and will continue to increase enrollment each year. The University has long term plans for the School to offer more programs at the undergraduate and graduate level. The School of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences will also lead Habib University's General Education Program, an interdisciplinary core that introduces students across disciplines to the liberal arts model of education. The General Education Program has been envisioned with exceptional faculty at Carnegie Mellon University (academic partners in development of Habib University).

The Communication Studies and Design (CSD) program is one of programs offered by the School of Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities at Habib University. It bases its curriculum in a thorough understanding of the ways in which semiotic and media systems both reflect and shape individual, political, and cultural being. Using this understanding as a foundation, it seeks to develop technical expertise in oral, print, visual, and online communication through project-based learning in authentic contexts.

Habib University is inviting applications for faculty positions at any level (assistant, associate or full professor) for appointment to its Communication Studies and Design program. We encourage applications from all areas of communications including journalism, advertising & public relations, comparative literature, philosophy, film studies, English, visual and graphic design, and linguistics and rhetoric, psychology, and other fields to apply.
